DALLAS – For the second year in a row, Corbett Lighting, renowned U.S. manufacturer of premium fixtures for residential, contract and hospitality use, has been recognized with the 23rd Annual ARTS Award for 2012.

Considered one of the industry's most prestigious citations, the ARTS Award was announced during the Dallas International Market and the Dallas Total Home & Gift Market on Saturday, January 21, 2012. This citation follows Corbett Lighting's receipt of the ARTS Award last year when it was named "Lighting Manufacturer of the Year." Nominations are made one year in advance by an independent panel of judges and awards are determined by vote from independent retailers, manufacturers and designers, sales representatives and other industry professionals. In partnership with the Dallas Market Center, the Accessories Resource Team (ART) has hosted the prestigious Annual ARTS Awards program for the past two decades.

This year's submission included the Dolcetti Pendant, a spectacularly elegant and ornate design that combines exotic shells, crystal and stainless steel accents into a breathtaking fixture. It is Dolcetti's innovate use of materials and exquisite handcraftsmanship that singles it out among the competition and makes it a standout for Corbett Lighting. In addition to the product, a handmade, elaborate binder discussing the Corbett Lighting brand, its history and product offerings, capabilities and initiatives was also prepared to supplement the submission.

"Given the brand's 40-year legacy and steadfast commitment to producing high-quality, fashion-forward, hand-crafted lighting fixtures, winning an ARTS award for a second consecutive year is an honor we can only hope embodies what we strive to achieve every day," says David Littman, CEO, Littman Brands. The ARTS Award process takes a full year; an independent panel of judges was selected in February 2011 and a call for nominations ran from March-June 2011. Through an online ballot system, retailers and industry professionals nominated decorative accessory manufacturers, product designers and sales representatives. Nominations were announced in August 2011 and finalists were asked to submit their entries in November.
